

Work Session

November 10, 2014

Acting President of Board of Aldermen Lisa Daugherty called session to order at 6:30 PM. Present were Aldermen Frank Herron, Barbara Welch, Roger Bone, Lisa Daugherty. City Attorney Mike Talley, David Weaver and 10 visitors were also present.

Bill 14-20 Set Base Engineering Fees and Increase Application Fee for Commercial Construction: Proposed ordinance would set base fee at \$2,000 and application fee at \$500. If fees were less than \$2,000, balance would be refunded. If more than \$2,000, landowner or contractor would be billed for overage, which must be paid prior to issuance of Certificate of Occupancy. Application fee would increase from \$255 to \$500.

Proposed Ordinance to Set Base Engineering Fees for Platted Sub-Division: Proposed ordinance to set base engineering fees would be same as for commercial construction. Changes made to Chapter 400 Land Use must go before Planning & Zoning Commission and Board of Aldermen in separate public hearings scheduled by Board.

Application for Successor Mayor: no discussion.

Select FY14 Auditor: Board wanted to advertise for bids.

Peddlers and Solicitors: City Attorney had draft ordinance along with samples from MML (Missouri Municipal League), Cities of Joplin and Ladue as handouts for Board to review and discuss at later date.
